






Of the 12 million acres planted in Montana in 2011, 8.6 million or 72% were enrolled in crop insurance. Of the insured acreage, 7 million were individual buy-up coverage, with 6 million (70% of acres; 67% of premiums) with a buy-up level of 75% or greater, while 236,000 (3%) were in CAT. Over 1.2 million acres (14%) were in area plans like GRP or GRIP.
